Victor and David Fernández de Manzanos are the 5th generation of a family dedicated to wine world, more than 130 years committed to the cultivation of the vine and the elaboration of quality wines in Rioja. Logroño, whose name refers to its birth next to the Ebro river and a city closely linked to the culture of wine, is the capital of La Rioja. Land of castles and vineyards, its history is the history of wine and grape harvest. The wine is reflected even in the garnet color of the Cross of San Andrés marked on its flag, a symbol of unity with the House of Burgundy. In Logroño, wine is present in every corner of the city. These wines reflect the rich diversity of terroir that the Appellation Rioja owns. It is all about selecting the grapes of different origin, climate, altitude and soil to capture the most faithful representation of this region.

Grapes come from the vineyards of "Rioja Alta" and "Rioja Oriental". Vineyards located in "Ribafrecha" of the Tempranillo variety planted in trellis with clay and limestone soil at 500-600 meters altitude and more than 30 years of age. "Uson" is a Grenache vineyard planted in trellis with sand and clay soil at 400-500 meters altitude and more than 30 years of age.

Complex, black fruit, licorice, spices and chocolate notes. Round and structured with pleasant ripe fruit notes.

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
